

## **Covid 19 - Safe working for Boat Owners and Crew wishing to launch**

These procedures have been put in place to safeguard the Launch Team as far as possible when they lift and launch your boat

Follow instructions from the Launch Team at all times

### **1. Arrival on site**

- Keep roadways clear
- Unload your car and park in the car park
- Do not touch or try to remove barrier fencing

### **2. Prior to launching**

Ensure your boat is ready for your chosen date. Does your engine start?!

### **3. Launch procedure**

Remove power cables, stow ladders and clear debris well before the Launch Crew arrive



Remain >2M away from Launch Team and your boat at all times during the lift and launch. Unless instructed by the Team person controlling the launch



You will be given time to patch/antifoul once the boat is moved from the cradle. Be ready with paint, roller/brush



Leave the yard and wait for your boat at the top of the slipway



Do not approach boat or Launch Team until blue boarding steps or ladder are in place and you are instructed to do so



Launch Team will place your boat in the water

### **4. After Launching**

- Liaise with Launch Team about tidying your layup site
- Do this as soon as possible on the same day, unless permission is given by the duty Driver and then within 24hours
- You will need to dismantle (if necessary) and stow your cradle on a pallet, without the assistance of the Launch Team
- Launch Teams are not permitted to help you dismantle or move your cradle, other than for forklift facilities
- Clear your rubbish and remove your old paint tins from site
